Consider hosting a recipe swap or inviting a guest speaker to share their heritage. These activities not only increase participation but also provide a platform for learning and connection. Usually, the food alone is enough to get people involved, but these ideas can add an extra layer of engagement!

Use Internal Communication Channels

Leverage internal communication tools like newsletters, intranets, or team meetings to spread the word. Include reminders and fun facts leading up to the event to keep everyone interested.

Event Checklist
